## 2019 SIBOR COMMITTEES **TASK FORCES & COMMUNITY FUNDRAISING EVENTS**

### COMMITTEES

#### **Appraisal Committee (CHAIR: Henry Salmon)**

– Creates meeting opportunities for Appraisers to discuss Local issues.

#### **Bylaws Committee (CHAIR: John Vernazza)**

– Maintains the governing documents of SIBOR. Reviews requirements of the National Association of Realtors® (NAR), the New York State Association of Realtors® (NYSAR) and local requirements to maintain the Bylaws, Policies and Procedures.

#### **Global Real Estate Summit (CHAIR/VICE CHAIR: TBA)**

– Encourages Realtors® to have a global perspective and coordinates an Annual Summit.

#### **Grievance Committee (CHAIR/VICE CHAIR: TBA – Selected by committee)**

– Carries out the initial review of Ethics complaints and financial disputes and refers them, when appropriate, to the Professional Standards Committee for hearings. Committee Members must have a real estate license for at least three (3) years and are typically required to complete a one-day training program with details to be determined. (Composition defined by Bylaws)

#### **Government/Legislative Affairs Committee (CHAIR: Dawn Carpenter)**

– Educates members on the importance of political awareness and active political involvement; keeps members informed on legislative issues related to our industry; identifies political candidates who support private property rights and other positions supportive of the real estate community, and recommends the distribution of RPAC funds to local elected officials and candidates for elected positions. (Composition defined by Bylaws)

#### **Nominating & Awards Committee (CHAIR: Greg Sokol)**

– Identifies, recruits and nominates future board Leadership and annual recipients of the Realtor® and Realtor Associate®-of-the-Year, and other Recognition Awards. (Composition defined by Bylaws)

#### **Professional Standards Committee (CHAIR: Angelo Pappalardo)**

– A pool of volunteers is used to compose hearing panels that arbitrate disputes and conduct Code of Ethics hearings in accordance with procedures established by the National Association of Realtors®. Committee Members must have a real estate license for at least three (3) years and are typically required to complete a one-day training program with details to be determined. (Composition defined by Bylaws)
