2020 SIBOR COMMITTEES & TASK FORCES

Awards & Nominating Committee (CHAIR: Greg Sokol)

Identifies & nominates annual recipients of the Realtor® and Realtor Associate®-of-the-Year, and other Recognition Awards; recruits and nominates future board Leadership.

Equal Opportunity & Cultural Diversity (CHAIR: Angelo Pappalardo)

Works to increase awareness and appreciation of the multicultural diversity of our community as well as eliminating discriminatory practices in housing.

Global Real Estate Council (CHAIR: Sari Kingsley; VICE CHAIR: Aldo Iemma)

Dedicated to globally themed education, programming and networking. Works to build awareness of the global business opportunities.

Grievance Committee (CHAIR/VICE CHAIR: TBA) Selected by Committee

Performs initial review of complaints and claims (filed by Realtors and the Public) regarding unethical conduct and financial disputes, referring them, when appropriate, to the Professional Standards Committee for hearings. Realtor participants must be licensed for a *minimum* of three (3) years and complete a one-day training program to be held on Friday, February 28, 2020.

Identifies and raises awareness of proposed legislation or local ordinances that affect real property rights or threats to our profession. It also raises awareness of the importance of the Realtor Political Action Committee (RPAC), creates fund raising events and develops initiatives to increase members voluntary contributions to RPAC

Professional Development (CHAIR: Robert Tuzzo; Staff Coordinator: Faye Koszta)

Develops and recommends educational programming, speakers, and events to enhance the professional development of our members.

Professional Standards Committee (CHAIR: John Vernazza; VICE CHAIR: Angelo Pappalardo)

A pool of volunteers is used to compose hearing panels that arbitrate disputes and conduct Code of Ethics hearings in accordance with procedures established by the National Association of Realtors®.
